

# FORMING SENTENCES

## B. One Noun + One Verb

"Tell me a sentence with these two words in it.  
You can use the words in any order you choose."

If the student changes a word, such as changing 'flew' to 'flying', say,  
"I want you to make your sentence with exactly the words I gave you.  
Try it again with the words \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_."

Students may find some verb tenses more difficult to use in a sentence.  
If your student doesn't know past tense words such as 'flew, had, built, fell," then substitute that verb for another word.

1. jumping - frog (eg "The frog is jumping")
2. pie - eats
3. wearing - coat
4. ball - kicked
5. fell - book
6. folded - clothes
7. picks - flowers
8. fed - baby
9. fish - catching
10. paper - cut
